

- Students must be entering 11th or 12th grade year by Fall 2011.
- Have a minimum 2.5 GPA in Math and Science
- Must live in City of Houston service area
- Must complete registration packet which includes:

 - *Evaluation by Math or Science teacher form*
 - *Student short essay form*
