



Requirements for Geotechnical Engineering and Construction Materials Testing for Firms Working on The City of Houston Projects

The Public Works and Engineering (PWE) Department of the City of Houston has certain requirements for firms to satisfy before they can perform Geotechnical Engineering projects and/or receive Construction Materials Testing (CMT) contracts. These requirements are as follows:

- Submitting PWE 100 form to the PWE Department once every two year;
- Having active accreditation by American Association for Laboratory Accreditation;
- Being managed by a full-time Professional Engineer registered in the state of Texas; and
- Having CMT technicians certified by agencies approved by the City of Houston.

The City of Houston will process CMT contract for a new firm once a year provided the above requirements are fulfilled by the firm, and the request for the new contract is received prior to September 30th of the year.
