



# City of Houston Public Works Mascot Contest Guidelines

**ELIGIBILITY: ELEMENTARY AGE 1<sup>ST</sup> - 5<sup>TH</sup> GRADE CLASSES WITH THEIR TEACHERS FROM ANY SCHOOL WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF HOUSTON.**

- 1. EACH CLASS MAY SUBMIT A NAME THAT CAPTURES THE ESSENCE OF THE MASCOT AND WHAT IT REPRESENTS: KEEPING GREASE OUT OF THE CITY'S SEWER SYSTEM. NAMES THAT ARE PROTECTED BY COPYRIGHT OR TRADEMARKS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
- 2. ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED ONLINE BY NOON, FRIDAY, MARCH 30, 2007 AT [WWW.CORRALTHEGREASE.ORG](http://WWW.CORRALTHEGREASE.ORG)**
- 3. PROVIDE THE TEACHER'S NAME, SCHOOL PRINCIPAL'S NAME, SCHOOL CONTACT INFORMATION, GRADE LEVEL, NUMBER OF STUDENTS IN THE CLASS (SEE WEBSITE FOR DETAILS).**
- 4. ONLY ONE WINNING NAME WILL BE SELECTED. IN CASE OF A TIE (SAME WINNING NAME SUBMITTED BY MORE THAN ONE ENTRANT), A DRAWING WILL BE HELD TO DETERMINE THE WINNING CLASS.**
- 5. THE WINNING CLASS, TEACHER AND PRINCIPAL WILL BE RECOGNIZED AT THE CITY OF HOUSTON WATER FESTIVAL, THURSDAY, MAY 10, 2007 AT THE DOWNTOWN AQUARIUM. ALL SCHOOLS/CLASSES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED FOR THEIR PARTICIPATION.**
