Exhibitors are invited to host an exhibit booth at the *WaterWorks for Houston Festival* Thursday, May 7, 2009 from 10:00 am-2:00 pm, at the Downtown Aquarium, 410 Bagby Street. Booth set-up time is from 8:00 am to 9:00 am.

The festival is an excellent opportunity to educate more than 2,000 students about the wonders of water. This year we are highlighting the flow of water in the Houston region.

To emphasize the importance of protecting water throughout the hydrological cycle, exhibits will be grouped according to these five categories:

- ◆ Storm to Source: Stormwater, watersheds, rivers, lakes, environmental protection – water issues north of downtown Houston
- ◆ Pure Houston Water: Drinking water operations, surface water treatment plants, groundwater, drinking water regulations, and laboratory testing
- ◆ Plant to Tap: Regional water authorities, planning, engineering, drinking water distribution system, maintenance and customer service
- ◆ Down the Drain: Household and commercial water use, wastewater, recycling, landscape irrigation, and related issues
- ◆ Bayous and Bays: Stormwater, wetlands, environmental protection – water issues south of downtown Houston

Each exhibit should have an identifiable message and provide students with an interactive learning experience related to the festival's theme, "*Protecting Our Water Resources.*"

Please return the attached registration form to request an exhibit space. Exhibit space (10'x10' tent, table and chairs) is provided, contingent upon exhibit relevance, educational merit, and space availability.

NOTE: The Aquarium provides parking validation for a maximum of 3 cars per exhibit booth.
